

# Woodstock Music Society Instructions for rehearsals in the Woodstock Community Centre

January 2022

These instructions are an update of the instructions the committee issued last term which were effectively followed by everyone. They follow Government guidelines for England and reflect the actions the Society has committed to take in the risk assessment approved by Woodstock Town Council in September 2021.

- Do not attend rehearsals if you are feeling unwell or are suffering from any respiratory, flu or COVID symptoms.
- The committee recommends that attendees should be fully vaccinated against COVID-19.
- Please ensure you have a negative result from a COVID-19 lateral flow test within 12 hours before each rehearsal.
- Unless exempt, you are currently required to wear a face covering in the Community Centre, except when rehearsing.
- The committee recommends that attendees make use of the hand sanitiser provided when entering the Community Centre.
- Orchestra players should bring and play from their own music stands.
- Be respectful towards others particularly when entering and leaving the rehearsal, allowing everyone space, and avoiding bottlenecks.
- Try to limit social conversations to outside the Community Centre.
- Ensure that you tick the attendance register at each rehearsal.
- Let the Secretary ([choir@woodstockmusic.info](mailto:choir@woodstockmusic.info) – 01993 812103) know immediately if you test positive for COVID-19 within 5 days after a rehearsal.
- Ensure you have warm clothing available because doors and windows will be open in the Community Centre to ensure adequate ventilation.
